As of September 27, 2024, GBL holds directly and through its subsidiaries 11,340,095 GBL shares representing 8.2% of the issued capital and holds no shares under the liquidity agreement. On that date, 37.6% of the seventh share buyback program is executed 1.

Following GBL's decision to use the safe harbour² regime for the on-the-market share buybacks in the context of a EUR 500 million envelope, the liquidity contract with an independent financial institution has been suspended for an indefinite period.
